GENERAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE ILS PROGRAM

1

Select compliant Facilities in and source from Permitted Sourcing Countries

2

Declare all Facilities and submit required documentation in a timely manner

3

Receive authorization from Disney prior to production

4

Manage ongoing compliance and provide periodic ILS Audits if required

5

Remediate compliance violations and stop production if required

6

Advise Disney promptly of Facility changes


SELECT COMPLIANT FACILITIES

 Permitted Sourcing Countries ILS Audit not required




SELECT COMPLIANT FACILITIES

- Some productions may only be authorized in facilities sourced through the <u>Better Work</u> program






DECLARE ALL FACILITIES AND SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION







SOCIAL COMPLIANCE AUDIT THAT MEETS DISNEY'S MCS (AS NEEDED)



DECLARE ALL FACILITIES AND SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION IN A TIMELY MANNER

QUALIFIED ILS AUDITS MUST BE:

- Less than 6 months old
- Include a full audit cycle
- Document working conditions
- Include interviews, document reviews, and visual inspections
- Include the physical address
- In English
- Provided electronically

FAMA AUTHORIZATION (MANDATORY)



MANAGE ONGOING COMPLIANCE AND PROVIDE ILS AUDITS IF REQUIRED

MONTHLY LICENSEE/VENDOR STATUS REPORT (MSR)

The report includes your production authorization statuses (current, pending and expired) and provides the following details:

- Actions required for Licensee/Vendor
- Facility details
- Last audit status and violations
- Next audit due date

Additional information from the report:

- Your Company ID (COM-XXXXXX)
- Contract information





MANAGE ONGOING COMPLIANCE AND PROVIDE ILS AUDITS IF REQUIRED

AUDITS CONDUCTED BY DISNEY (DDA AUDITS)

- Disney may perform ILS audits of any facility, at any time, in any country.
- Disney will notify in advance of an ILS audit
- Facility information should be accurate
- Ensure Disney has full access to the facility
- UTS (Unable to Schedule) notification





REMEDIATE COMPLIANCE VIOLATIONS AND STOP PRODUCTION IF REQUIRED

CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN

- MCS violations
- Non-MCS violations
- Two consecutive audits that fail MCS = Facility Loss of Production Authorisation (FLOPA)

Tip: Share the CAP letter with facility management and work with them to solve the issues

Results of this audit indicate that this facility currently rest Dine, 's Myimum Compliance Standard (MCS) under the ILS Program.

ADVISE DISNEY PROMPTLY OF FACILITY CHANGES

- No longer using the facility for Disney-branded production?
- Check Monthly Status Report to ensure the facility details are correct
